

2014 Delaware County Farm Festival Ag Scholarship Program

The Delaware County Farm Festival Committee and Farm Credit Services have combined to offer 2 scholarships at \$500 each annually through our organizational scholarship program designed to help students pursue an education in agriculture, finance or an agriculture-related field of study. The scholarships are open to high school seniors, current college students, members of the Delta Future Farmers of America, and participants of the Delaware County Farm Festival for a minimum of two (2) years. Students must also have a minimum GPA of 3.0. Priority will be given to those pursuing a degree in any of the following agricultural-related studies: Agribusiness and Applied Economics, Agricultural Communications, Agricultural Engineering, Agricultural Systems Management, Agronomy, Animal Sciences, Bio Chemistry, Botany and Plant Pathology, Entomology Food Science, Forestry and Natural Resources, Horticulture, Landscape Architecture, Youth Development and Agricultural Education, Agriculture Information Technology, Agricultural Business Management, Agricultural Sales and Marketing, or any other agricultural related field.

GUIDELINES AND ELIGIBILITY

Scholarships are awarded based on academic record, leadership qualities, and community involvement.

Enrolled in the College of Agriculture or Business

Cumulative grade point average of 3.0 is preferred

Ag background or work-related experience in agriculture

A minimum of two years service to the Delaware County Farm Festival

Must submit an essay on how you plan to use your major in the chosen career (tab 4 of this application)

Graduating high school seniors or current college students are eligible to apply
